FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT:,

Some of you may have seen the picture of the soil sample from one of our greens showing a fungus and bacteria layer several inches underground. Part of the solutions to that problem was to use a deep tine (9 inches) to plug the greens and fill the holes with sand. This allows for moisture to move through the greens and not be trapped where fungus and bacteria will thrive. We regretted having to do that just before a tournament, but we tried to get the greens as smooth as possible.
